In 1956 a small band of faithful men and women began with a dream and a rented campground. That dream would grow into a reality of service for generations. In 1965, seventy-eight acres of land were purchased in Eustis, Florida and the Central Florida Bible Camp was given a permanent home.

HANKFUL FOR OUR PAST, PREPARING FOR OUR FUTURE

Central Florida Bible Camp is a thriving ministry that is serving the whole person. Yet, as we seek to meet the needs of a new generation, it is time to reimagine and equip for the future. The camp's board of directors has spent countless hours dreaming, praying, researching and planning as we prepare to move forward. The board recognizes the legacy that has been created at CFBC, and are excited to move forward in building upon that legacy for the future.

THE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN WILL MOVE FORWARD IN THREE PHASES:

PHASE ONE (\$1 MILLION)

- A New Girls' Cabin Unit (see plan a): It will sleep 20 people on each side with separate restrooms and a common conference room.
- A New Swimming Pool and Bathhouse (see plan b): The swimming pool will provide a water sports area and a general swimming area.
 It will be able to accommodate 50+ swimmers and will also allow for future added features, such as a water slide.
- Relocating the current RV sites and expanding utilities to allow for future building and expansion.
- Converting the current Kahler Cottage (see plan c) into new staff quarters and clinic.





PHASE TWO (\$1 MILLION)

- Demolition of six of the current boys cabins. Because of their age and condition, these cabins are not suitable for our future needs.
- Three New Boys' Cabins (see plan a): These duplex units will be identical to the Girls'
 Cabin built in phase one.
- The current Bunkhouse Building will be converted into a new Camp Store and Canteen.

PHASE THREE (\$1 MILLION)

- A New Conference and Activity Center: This facility will be used for retreats, conference space, bible classes, devotionals, small group dining and much more.
- Expansion of the Chapel: The current chapel will be enlarged to allow for more seating and an improved media area. There will be a large platform in the front of the chapel to better accommodate the different camp activities.
- Dining Hall and Kitchen Expansion: The dining room will be expanded to accommodate more seating. The kitchen will be enlarged and updated. New restrooms will be built.

Central Florida Bible Camp has served several generations of young people well. Many of the men and women who grew up attending the CFBC, acknowledge that the camp played a significant role in shaping them into who they are today. We are thankful for our past and excited for our future. As we move FORWARD, the camp will be better equipped to serve future generations.
